

Peninsula Equestrian Circuit, Inc. is proud to present the 2021 Horse Show CAMP – JULY 11

 - New for 2021: Adaptive Riding Class (Therapeutic Special Needs Riding Class)
 - These special needs riders are new to our program ...***please be considerate and welcome them to our horse show “camp”.***
- **As part of the camp format, we will have one all-inclusive entry fee for each horse/rider combination**
 - This fee covers: Trainer’s warmup, all rider’s classes, all fees (i.e. office, ground) as well as the Annual Membership/High Point for 1 division.
 - **First time “campers”** the fee is **\$400 per horse/rider**
 - 2019 = \$435 average per horse /rider at first show with annual membership
 - **Repeat “campers”** (i.e. you have already paid the \$400 fee): is **\$300 per horse/ rider.**
 - 2019 = \$305 average per horse/rider once annual membership paid
 - Annual High Point for a 2nd division is **\$120 per horse/rider**
 - **Leadline & Adaptive Riding Classes are \$25 per horse/rider**
- Since we are not a formal horse show (due to COVID), results cannot be posted online.
- **All Entries (including waiver) must be received no later than Wednesday, July 7.**

- Trainer Warmups run from start 6:30 – 7:45am.
- **Judged classes start at promptly at 8am.**
 - Ribbons 1st – 8th place. High Point Champion and Reserve in all Divisions with at least 3 riders.

For our Horse Show Camp, we will follow the Horse Show Rules as outline above as well as established in the 2020 Peninsula Equestrian Circuit Premium in regards to General Rules, Horse and Exhibitor, Class Requirements, Class Descriptions, and Cross Entries as closely as possible taking into consideration the Camp Format.
